#### EAST CHARLOTTE DRAINAGE DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING JANUARY 17, 2023

#### A. CALL TO ORDER

The January 17, 2023, Regular Board Meeting of the East Charlotte Drainage District (the "District") was called to order at 9:03 a.m. in the Charlotte Harbor Event Conference Center located at 75 Taylor Street, Punta Gorda, Florida 33950.

#### B. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

#### C. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Proof of publication was presented that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Fort Myers News-Press* on October 7, 2022, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

#### D. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

#### E. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

#### F. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

#### G. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. November 15, 2022, Rescheduled Regular Board Meeting

The November 15, 2022, Rescheduled Regular Board Meeting minutes were presented for consideration.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Kemeny, seconded by Mr. Phillip Varner and passed unanimously approving the November 15, 2022, Reschedule Regular Board Meeting minutes, as presented.

#### H. OLD BUSINESS

There were no Old Business items to come before the Board.

#### I. NEW BUSINESS

#### 1. Discussion Regarding Reinstating Crews Bank Line of Credit

Ms. Meneely went over the background of the application, noting that the Board had decided to move forward with reinstating the line of credit for \$100,000. The Board discussed the necessary information, including: the District will be the borrowing entity; SDS staff, Tori Shamy and Kathleen Meneely, are approved individuals, in addition to the Board Members to obtain information; Chairman Zachary Varner is authorized to execute the loan documents and make draws; and that pledged funding comes from future tax receipts.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Phillip Varner, seconded by Mr. Kemeny and passed unanimously to continue moving forward with reinstating the line of credit with approval of all stipulations above recited.

#### 2. Consider Paving Proposal for Asphalt Overlay on Graham Road

Mr. Kemeny advised that he had obtained a quote from C & M Paving for the asphalt overlay of ¾ mile at the south end on Graham Road at a cost of \$66,408. He added that the quote was overbudget and Alico will pay the balance with the District's cost-share being \$24,241. Discussion ensued with Ms. Meneely asking that the contractor provide an agreement for the amount the District was responsible for paying.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Phillip Varner, seconded by Mr. Zachary Varner and passed unanimously approving the proposal from C & M Paving for the asphalt overlay of ¾ mile at the south end on Graham Road for the District's portion in the amount of \$24,241.

#### 3. Discussion Regarding D'Antuono Litigation

Mr. Diffenderfer stated that the District had been invited by the Bickett lawyer to join litigation against D'Antuono. He went over the background of the issue, stating the Districts' records had been pulled by the lawyer and they were looking for rights to use the Gleason easement in Section 23 of the Bickett property. He added that motions for summary judgment were to be heard in February with a March trial, if there is no summary judgment. He continued by stating, in the past, the position of the District was that this area ws private on Neal Road, but the District was being asked to intervene and support Bickett. He added that the District can file an affidavit, but the public records have already been given to the party. Mr. Zachary Varner indicated that he agreed with Bickett, but that this was not the District's fight. After discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to monitor the litigation and report back, but not to get involved.

### J. MANAGER'S REPORT

#### a. Financial Report

Ms. Meneely went over the financials. The Board had no questions.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Phillip Varner, seconded by Mr. Kemeny and passed unanimously accepting the Financial Report, as presented.

Ms. Meneely also advised the Board that she had, once again, been contacted by the member of the Bermont Drainage District about possibly joining the District, but had informed them of the costs and procedures involved.

#### K. FIELD REPORT

Mr. Shattles went over his report, pointing out that rainy season was coming and that help was needed in order to keep the drains clean and pipes cleaned out. He added that Joshua Drainage District did not have enough people to keep them clean.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Phillip Varner, seconded by Mr. Zachary Varner and passed unanimously accepting the Field Report, as presented.

#### L. ENGINEER'S REPORT

There was no Engineer's Report at this time.

#### M. ATTORNEY'S REPORT

Ms. Meneely stated that Mr. Lewis had retired and that Robert Diffenderfer along with Seth Behn, both from Mr. Lewis' firm, would now serve in the role as the District's attorneys. Both attorneys went over their backgrounds and their assistance to Mr. Lewis over his many years of service to the District.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Phillip Varner, seconded by Mr. Kemeny and passed unanimously acknowledging the new attorneys who will represent the District.

#### N. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Ms. Meneely advised that the next meeting was scheduled for April 18, 2023.

#### O. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

There were no further Board Member comments.

#### P. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, a **motion** was made by Mr. Phillip Varner, seconded by Mr. Kemeny and passed unanimously adjourning the Regular Board Meeting at 9:47 a.m.

Dear Ms. Meneely,

I represent the interests of Marchella D'Antuono, the owner of 160 acres in a certain area of unplatted Charlotte County described as Section 23, Township 40 South, Range 26 East. My client's property is just outside the boundary of the East Charlotte Drainage District ("ECDD").

The purpose of this letter is to follow up a phone call that I had with Robert Diffenderfer, counsel for the ECDD. We briefly discussed the issues that my client is dealing with and he advised that I provide a brief description to you and request that the matter be brought before the ECDD Board for consideration.

Essentially, my client is one of the few properties in this rural area of Charlotte County that does not have the benefit of being included in a drainage district. Almost every other property surrounding my client's property has been incorporated into a drainage district. As mentioned above, my client's property lies just outside of the ECDD territory which begins at the Section 22 boundary.

My client would like to engage the ECDD in conversation regarding the possibility of entering into an agreement with the ECDD, whereby my client would be granted access through Section 22 to access Graham Road north to Neal Road or south to Bermont Road. Obviously, my client is aware that property owners within the ECDD are required to make payment to assist in the maintenance and construction of roads and drainage ditches within the ECDD territory. My client would certainly be willing to pay her share to assist in the maintenance of same.

If you would please advise as to what is needed from my client in order to get this matter in front of the ECDD Board it would be greatly appreciated. I was advised that the Board meets quarterly and that the next meeting would take place in either March or April.

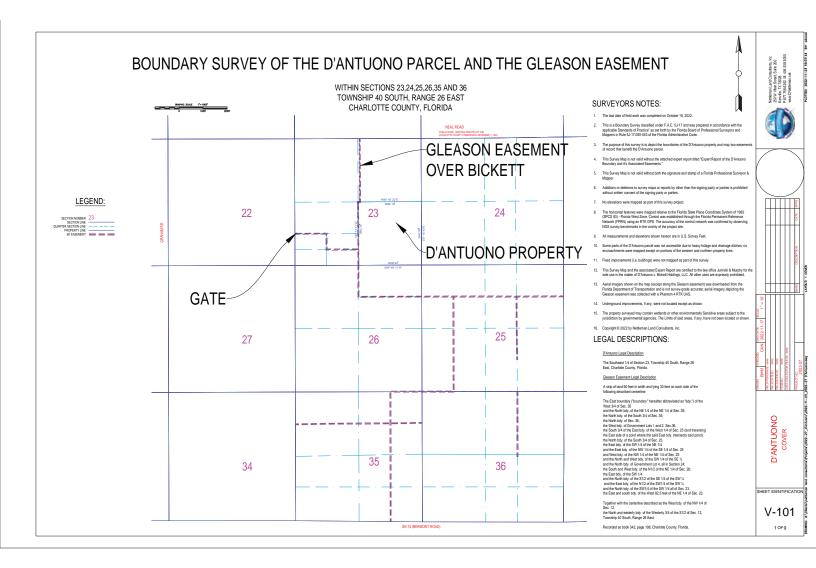

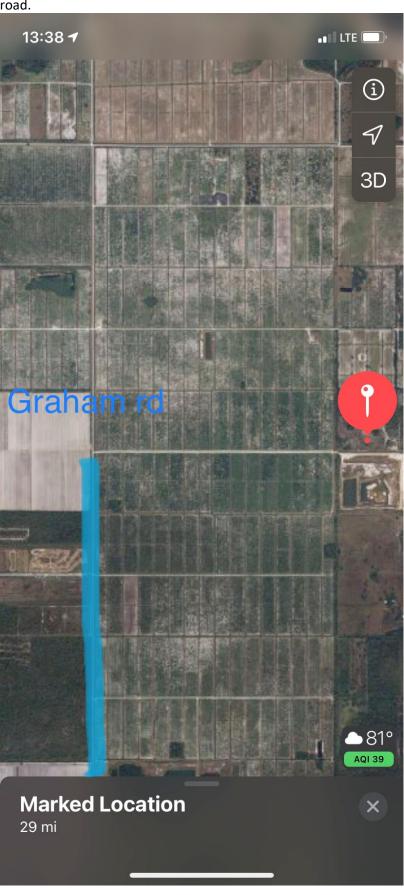
