

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE EAST CHARLOTTE DRAINAGE DISTRICT AUTHORIZING AND ADOPTING AN AMENDED FINAL FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023 BUDGET, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 197, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Phillip Verner, seconded by Mr. Kemeny and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2023-05, as presented.

2. Discussion Regarding Hauling on Graham Road for Motor Cross Park

Kurt Traulsen indicated that he had purchased property for an RV & Motor Cross Park and he is requesting use of Graham Road. Mr. Kemeny stated that access was for emergency services such as ambulances only and that was granted about 7 years ago. He added that this property was not part of the ECDD and others have been turned down due to the costs to maintain and the time to manage. Zachary Varner added that it would cost the District plus the District would have liability. Mr. Behn stated that the roads were not built for public access and we are not a "road district". Further discussion ensued after which a **motion** was made by Mr. Kemeny, seconded by Mr. Phillip Varner and passed unanimously denying Mr. Traulsen's request. Mr. Kemeny pointed out that they have access through other means.
